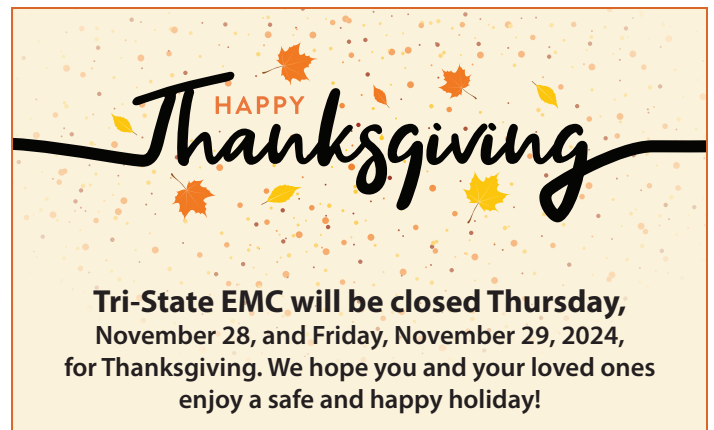


VETERANS DAY
